## PRIZE

### FRANCESCO BERLINGIERI

On the occasion of the centenary of the birth of Francesco Berlingieri on 20 February 1922, the Journal “Il Diritto Marittimo” establishes a contest to award a prize in his memory.

Francesco Berlingieri started to collaborate with the Journal in 1946, participating in its contents with his papers for over 70 years. A member of the Board of Assistant Editors from 1948, and joining the Board of Editors in 1956, he became co-Editor in 1972 and Editor in Chief in 1974.

During the time that he was involved with the Journal he devoted much care and attention to assisting young people when they were contributing articles or case notes to often welcoming them into his office to correct their papers and to suggest amendments.

In his memory it has been decided to establish a Prize which, based on the Rules attached hereto, will be awarded to the person of 35 years or younger who submits the winning Essay on a topic relating to maritime law.

## PRIZE FRANCESCO BERLINGIERI

### RULES

1. The prize will be awarded following a contest to be run annually unless otherwise decided by the Editors of the Journal.
2. Candidates should be 35 years of age or younger on the date when the contest is held and may be of any nationality.
3. Notice of the contest will be given to Subscribers to the Journal and will be duly published.
4. Candidates wishing to submit an Essay will follow the rules established in the notice of the contest. Candidates will receive an enrolment form, to be returned duly completed.  
Candidates will be provided with an identification code to be included in the Essay in order to avoid the use of their names or personal data. Failure to use the code will lead to disqualification.
5. The Essays submitted will be assessed by a Jury appointed each time the contest takes place and made up of three members appointed by the Editors of the Journal from among the members of the Board of Editors and of the Scientific Board. The selection of the Essay to which the prize is to be awarded will not be subject to appeal. The Jury may also decide not to select any of the Essays submitted, with the consequence that the prize will not be awarded.
6. Essays submitted by Candidates must be written in Italian or English and have a length between 7,500 and 20,000 words, inclusive of footnotes.
7. The name of the winner will be announced within three months from the date set for the Essays to be submitted.
8. The prize will consist of (i) publication of the Essay in the Journal, (ii) three years subscriptions to the Journal starting from the year when the prize is awarded and (iii) copies of the available volumes of the indexes of the previous five years and of the volumes on the Essays in Honor of Francesco Berlingieri.
9. The announcement of the prize winner will be made at an event organized by the Journal to be named "Francesco Berlingieri Day". On that occasion the winner will be invited to make a presentation based upon the contents of the winning Essay.
10. The prize will not be awarded more than once to the same person.
